Smart and Skilled

Smart and Skilled is a reform of the NSW vocational education and training system. It's helping people get the skills they need to be more successful. The various Skills and Industry Policy Regional Offices in NSW are looking for local companies who need subsidised training to assist with engaging their personnel to improve productivity, reduce costs, and impress their customers.

Since January 2016 and again for 2018-2019, CTPM has been offered and has accepted a Smart and Skilled contract to be an approved training provider for the NSW Department of Industry to deliver the:

- Smart and Skilled Targeted Priorities Prevocational and Part Qualification Program.

This training is subsidised by the NSW Government.

Who qualifies to receive Smart and Skilled subsidised training?

Any personnel on site, who are aged 15 years and older; no longer at school; living or working in New South Wales; and an Australian Citizen, a permanent Australian resident, a humanitarian visa holder or a New Zealand Citizen.

The funding is available no matter what other qualifications they have previously achieved.
